- This form must be signed by the applicant, and a completed "Summary of Entries" form (SPC 3) attached with payment.

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

1. The Seed Sown Reference Number box shows the unique crop numbering system. This number is printed on the certification tags and also listed in the Seed Potato Certification List of certified crop grower's booklet.
2. Remember to include a tag for each entry.
3. Remember to sign your entry.
4. If a farm you want to grow a crop on does not have an official Farm number (ROP number), contact the Seed Certification Bureau.
5. Closing Dates: **21 days after planting** (Remember we need to process your entry and send the inspection form to the inspector BEFORE the 1st inspection is due).
