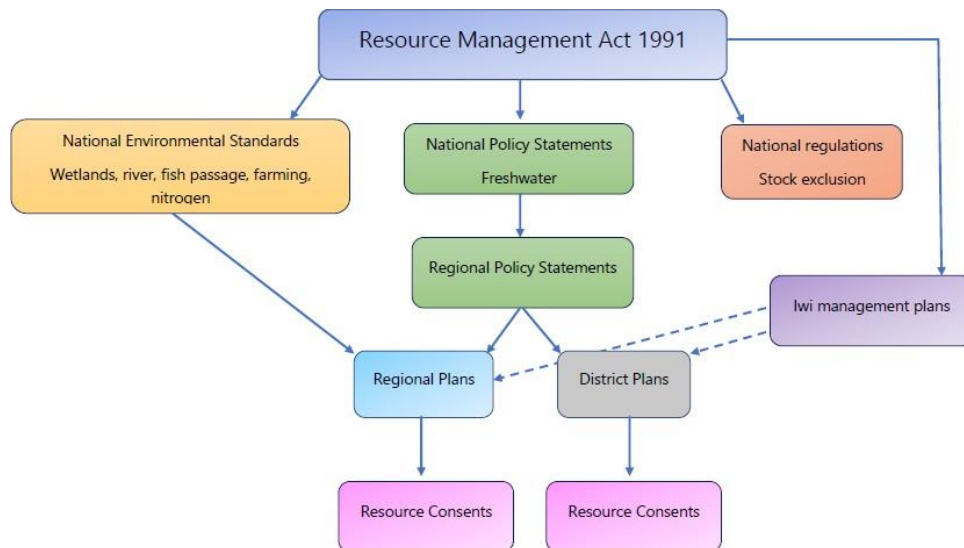


POLICY AND PLAN CHANGES – THE CHAIN OF COMMAND



Clarification on the basics of what the National Policy Statement for Freshwater may mean for industry.

The proposed freshwater reforms mostly roll out what already happens and works well in the Canterbury region, including:

- ✓ FEPs
- ✓ Implementation of Good Management Practice
- ✓ FEP Audits
- ✓ Limits on intensification
- ✓ Stock Exclusion
- ✓ Controls of feedlots and stock holding areas
- ✓ Protection of Wetlands
- ✓ Enhancement of fish passage
- ✓ Water quality bottom lines, including new limits for sediment, *E.coli* and phosphorus
- ✓ New controls for stormwater and wastewater overflow
- ✓ Adaptive management approach

Other things they are proposing to include are:

- 1ppm DIN water quality bottom line
- 5m average setback for fencing of waterways
- Consents for intensification in Canterbury
